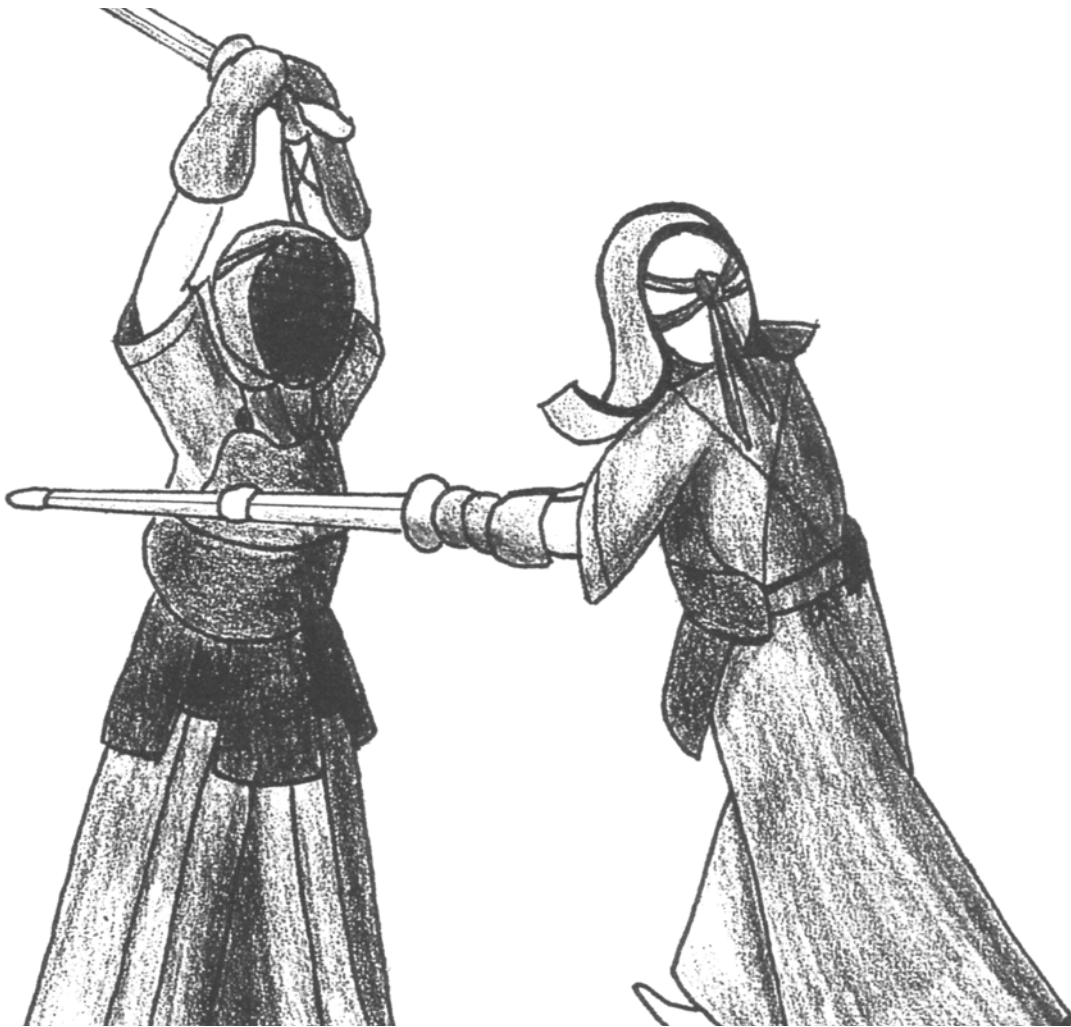

ATTENTION TOURNAMENT PARTICIPANTS:

ATTENTION 3 DAN AND ABOVE:

- All 3 dan and above will be assigned a court to assist with judging.

ATTENTION PROMOTION EXAM CANDIDATES:

Ensure you complete Form 3 (Liability Waiver Form) from Section 1, and all promotion exam registration materials in Section 2 (Promotion Registration Information). Pay special attention to specific instructions related to testing/menjo fees. Please complete and submit all *promotion exam* - related forms and checks to your Dojo/Club Representative.

Reminder: The new Bokuto Ni Yoru Kendo Kihon-Waza Keiko-Ho will be required at this promotion for the following ranks:

- 4 kyu need to know 1 – 3
- 3 kyu need to know 1 – 6
- 2 kyu need to know 1 – 9

- Please submit ONE packet to include both Tournament and Promotion Exam materials.
- Please submit ONE check for Tournament Fees AND Promotion Exam Fees (excluding Menjo Fees) for your entire group (check payable to **Charlotte Kendo Club**)
- For Menjo fees, each individual candidate should submit a separate individual check (payable to **Charlotte Kendo Club**) (unsuccessful candidates' menjo fee checks will be destroyed.)
- Please try your best to keep Tournament materials and Promotion materials separate in your group package.
- Please complete and include Form 4 (Dojo Representative Form)
- Please complete and include Form 5 (Team Division Roster). *You may submit an updated Team Roster at check-in on the day of the tournament.*
- Please ensure your math is correct!

- Describe in detail the elements of “Yuko-datotsu”
- Describe in detail the importance of kirikaeshi
